<p>EMPLOYMENT/ EDUCATION</p>  <p>Denial of unemployment benefits, job discrimination, and special education concerns.</p>	<p>INCOME</p>  <p>Denials, cut offs, or reductions in public assistance, SNAP (food stamps) applications, and Social Security denials (SSI & SSD).</p>	<p>HOUSING</p>  <p>Landlord lock-outs, housing conditions, other landlord/tenant problems, and foreclosure concerns.</p>
<p>CONSUMER</p>  <p>Debt collection, wage garnishments, IRS & NYS tax concerns, and utility problems.</p>	<p>HEALTH</p>  <p>Medicaid & Medicare, private health insurance, health care proxies, and long term care.</p>	<p>FAMILY</p>  <p>Domestic abuse, some child support or spousal support matters, wills, and advance planning.</p>
