The Legal Aid Society of Northeastern New York provides free legal advice and services to eligible low-income residents for a variety of civil (not criminal) legal problems including, but not limited to:

EMPLOYMENT/ EDUCATION



Denial of unemployment benefits, job discrimination, and special education concerns.

INCOME



Denials, cut offs, or reductions in public assistance, SNAP (food stamps) applications, and Social Security denials (SSI & SSD).

HOUSING



Landlord lock-outs, housing conditions, other landlord/ tenant problems, and foreclosure concerns.

CONSUMER



Debt collection, wage garnishments, IRS & NYS tax concerns, and utility problems.

HEALTH



Medicaid & Medicare, private health insurance, health care proxies, and long term care.

FAMILY



Domestic abuse, some child support or spousal support matters, wills, and advance planning.

We have special programs available in some counties including the HIV/AIDS Law Consortium, Senior Legal Services, and the Children's Legal Project.
